C. Norm gave an update to the member container and how it has power and track installed in the container. The bridge needs to be installed. Rick Kight is building a locking mechanism. The door also needs some work as it is hard to close.

- D. Norm also mentioned another member container is in the mix and will most likely be installed near the current red container. Some ground work needs to be started in preparation of the next container. Those interested in being in the next container are being finalized.
- E. Shop Container project Norm mentioned the containers are in place and ready for the next phase which includes sealing the containers, getting electrical and water run, cutting out the center walls, and more. Ethel and Norm talked about going over to Ethels to take a look at the Mill and figure out how it can be moved to the container. The Mill is a Bridgeport Series 1.
- F. Ethel commented on the container projects and was wondering what will be done to make sure they look good and we are not hurting the looks of the property. Discussion was had regarding other locations for future containers and Dale Grice suggested having a mural painted on the containers to give it a more decorative look. Additional suggestions around possible shrubs or plants around the container were made as well.
- G. Riding car truck repairs- Norm mentioned getting the rest of the riding car trucks next on the list. Going to get with Scott to make sure he has the parts for the brakes. He wants to bring two riding cars at a time to his shop and do the rebuild. Most of the wheels look good and if we need new wheels they will be \$50 each already machined from Little Engines.
- H. Reminder that the Trains, Trains, Trains! at the Southern Museum of Civil War & Locomotive history is coming up. Wayne Lass encouraged everyone to volunteer and check out the museum. At this point Peter will be displaying his locomotive, Dan will bring his diesel, and David Eisman will bring his caboose.

- 1. During our only two public run days in 2021 Sherry Moore helped out with the merchandise table and has discussed some ideas on what we may be able to do to enhance our fundraising efforts with merchandise. She is going to work on putting together more details and suggestions.
